Are you in an abusive relationship?

- Do you find yourself making excuses or minimizing your partner's behavior?
- Is your partner threatening or violent towards you or the children?
- Do you feel completely controlled by your partner? • Do you feel helpless, trapped, alone, and isolated?
- Do you blame yourself for the violence?
- O Does your partner blame you and tell you that you are the cause of all their problems?
- Does your partner constantly accuse you of having affairs whenever they can't account for 100% of your time? Do they tell you that jealousy is a sign of love?
- Do you find yourself lying to hide your partner's real behavior? (such as saying you fell when actually you were pushed)

If the answers to any of these questions are "Yes". help is available. You are not alone.
